

## ASHFORD SCHOOL ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION

- 1. The Association shall be called the ASHFORD SCHOOL ASSOCIATION
- 2. Any former pupil or former staff member of Ashford School, Ashford Girls School & Friars Prep School is eligible to be a Member of the Association. Honorary membership may be granted to the current Head of the School, and team members working in the Alumni & Development Office.
- 3. A Committee shall be elected at the AGM to conduct the business of the Association, which is to keep its Members in contact with one another and the School
- 4. There shall be a President and Vice President of the Association who will serve for a term of four years, at the end of which they will be eligible for re-election at the AGM by the Members. There will also be three Officers elected for the following term who are also eligible for re-election at the AGM by the members:
  - a. Chairman (3 Year Term)
  - b. Hon. Secretary (3 Year Term)
  - c. Hon. Treasurer (3 Year Term)
- 5. Voting will take place by show of hands at the AGM; if need be a secret ballot will be conducted if there is more than one candidate. In the event of a tie the Chair has the casting vote or in the case of the Chairman's position, the President has the casting vote.
- 6. The Committee shall have the power to co-opt Committee Members. The Alumni and Development Officer shall be a co-opted member.
- 7. The Chairman shall convene not fewer than one Committee meeting every term. Three Committee Members, including one Officer present shall form a quorum. Notice of the meeting shall be given to each Committee Member 14 days in advance.
- 8. A record of all Committee decisions shall be kept at each meeting and circulated to all Committee Members.
- 9. The Committee shall decide which publications to issue to Members.
- 10. The Committee shall maintain a liaison with the School via the Alumni & Development Office.
- 11. There shall be an Annual General Meeting of the Association Members during the Summer Term, notice of which shall be given at least 28 days prior to the meeting. 5 members present shall form a quorum.
- 12. The Hon. Treasurer shall submit to the AGM a statement of the Association's income and expenditure for the past year and the Committee's forecast of income and expenditure for the year ahead.
- 13. The Alumni & Development Office shall report to the AGM on the Association's Membership.



- 14. A record shall be kept of the business conducted at each AGM and approved at the next AGM.
- 15. If Ashford School no longer exists then the ASA shall continue as an organisation for as long as it remains solvent.
