

Appearance and Uniform

Pupils must be well turned out at all times and their appearance should not be ostentatious. Uniform should be clean (uniform does not need to be cleaned any more often than usual, nor does it need to be cleaned using methods which are different from normal), in good repair and worn properly.

Blazers are to be worn throughout the school day but may be removed in lessons with the permission of the teacher. Hair should be neat and tidy. Colours should be natural looking and any cuts or colours should not be extreme. If a pupil is in doubt then advice should be sought from their Head of Year prior to the cut or colour change. Makeup and piercings are not permitted, nor is jewellery, with the exception of a single, small pair of ear studs.
