Scholarship Terms and Conditions

A pupil who receives a scholarship award is required to work hard, to contribute positively to the life of the School, to be a credit to the School and to set a good example to other pupils. These are the *Purposes of the Award*.

Parents are expected to support and encourage the pupil to achieve the Purposes of the Award and to uphold the aims and the good name of the School.

Art Scholars are expected to set a good example to other art students by participating in and entering various publicised competitions and exhibitions. They should model exemplary behaviour within all art lessons, lead group discussions and showcase their artwork in a positive and supportive manner. Art Scholars are required to study Art at GCSE and continue to study Art at A level.

A scholarship award may be withdrawn if, in the opinion of the Governors, the pupil or a parent has not complied with the obligations set out above or the pupil has fallen below the required standards of conduct and progress and, in the further opinion of the Governors, there has been no significant improvement following consultation with a parent and/or the pupil and a written warning. Withdrawal of the award shall take effect from the start of the following term.
