



**Working Parent Entitlement - 9 months to 36 months  
Bridge & The Stables Nursery  
Summer Term 2026**

We are delighted to be offering the Working Parent Entitlement for eligible working families with a child aged 9-36 months at Bridge & The Stables Nurseries.

As Bridge and The Stables Nurseries offer year-round provision, **we are offering the hours stretched over 48 weeks** (up to 24 hours per week). Where the 'stretched offer' leads to children exceeding their free early education hours across the year, you will be given the option of removing your child from the setting or paying for the additional hours above the fundings allowance for the year.

Please find enclosed the fee schedule showing the fees payable to Ashford School for the provision of nursery education during Summer Term 26, where there is an entitlement. The schedule reflects period 20 April to 24 August 2026 (inclusive) in line with the KCC calendar. The days 25-28 August 2026 are non-funded and will be charged at the Nursery's usual day rate.

Our sessions will remain as they are currently with school days and extended days available for your child. We do not provide part days as we feel educationally and operationally these are not in the best interests of the children or the Nursery settings. Please see our schedule of fees on our website for further information.

If you are eligible to receive the funding, please be advised that this will become available to you the term after they turn 9 months. Please provide your valid eligibility code to your chosen nursery setting. To keep your Working Parent Entitlement funded childcare place you need to check your details are up to date with KCC every 3 months.

If you would like to access 24 hours Working Parent Entitlement (in line with the stretched funding offer) without incurring any charges you can do so between 1.30pm and 6.30pm Monday to Thursday and between 2.00pm-6.00pm on a Friday; places will be subject to availability. If your child is only accessing WPE during the above-mentioned hours, there will be no registration fee or deposit. The School's standard notice periods do not apply to WPE funded places, so there will be no fees in lieu of notice and we are unable to suspend or terminate the provision.

### First time claiming

Parents who are claiming for the first time will need to apply for the 11-digit code on the Childcare Choices website and provide this to Kay Divall at Bridge Nursery and Carly Olajide at The Stables Nursery. Certain rules do apply. For further information please check <https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/>

At the start of the school term after your child turns 9 months old, or if you have not previously claimed the Working Parent Entitlement but now wish to do so, you will be asked to complete and sign a Parental Declaration Form. To complete the claim, the parent who opened the childcare account will need to complete the form. **Please ensure that you complete and sign this document, so that we can submit the claim for Working Parent Entitlement on your behalf.**

You will need the following information with you:

- Your national insurance number
- Your child's original birth certificate or current passport
- The 11-digit code

The parental declaration forms must be completed on site.

### Continuing claims

Parents that claimed the Working Parent Entitlement previously will need to reconfirm their code and re-sign the parental declaration form. These will be available in the nursery office with Kay Divall at Bridge Nursery and Carly Olajide at The Stables Nursery.

<u>Timescales for new and continuing claims</u>
Parent Declaration Forms will be available from the Nursery office from <b>6 November until 21 November 2025</b> . Please see Kay Divall at Bridge Nursery and Carly Olajide at The Stables Nursery.
If the forms are not completed within this timeframe, we may not be able apply the funding to your Summer term invoice.
